

## **2020-2021 Waldwick School District and School Grade Report**

The HIB grade assessment includes eight core elements that address all of the ABR requirements for schools. The school safety team assigns a rating for each indicator based on the criteria and the available documentation. The maximum grade a school can receive is 78. Self assessments are not equivalent to letter assessments. Each indicator receives a number based on the indicator:

Exceeds the requirements - 3

Meets the requirements - 2

Partially meets the requirements -1

Does not meet the requirements - 0

A perfect score on each indicator of each pillar results in a 78.

The self assessment is done yearly by the School Safety team, reviewed and submitted to the state by the CSA. The report is also presented to the community and will be posted on the district website and each school website once the state releases the official copy.
