Dear Parent/Guardian,

- If someone in your household is being tested for COVID-19, all children must remain home until you receive the test results. Please notify the school nurse that testing is being done. This is extremely important in order to protect the health and safety of all our staff and students at Crescent School. If test results are negative, children may return to school. If the test results are positive, please contact the school immediately for further instructions.
- If your child has been exposed to someone outside your household who is being tested, your child must also remain home until you receive notification of test results.

What to do if your child is ill:

- Call the attendance line to report your child's illness, listing all symptoms.
- **Column A symptoms:** fever, chills, shivers, muscle aches, headache, sore throat, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, fatigue, congestion, runny nose
- **Column B symptoms:** cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, new loss of taste, new loss of smell.
- If your child has **TWO** symptoms from Column A **OR ONE** symptom from Column B
 - **If a COVID TEST IS DONE**, the child must stay home until you have results AND be fever free for 24 hours with improved symptoms. The school will need a copy of the test results.
 - **If COVID TEST IS NEGATIVE**- stay home until fever free for 24 hours and improved symptoms.
 - **if COVID TEST IS POSITIVE**-stay home for 10 days from the day the test was done AND fever free 24 hours and symptoms are improving. **NOTIFY THE SCHOOL IMMEDIATELY OF THE POSITIVE TEST RESULT.**
 - **If you do not see your Health care provider, your child MUST stay home for 10 days from the start of symptoms.**
- If your child has one symptom from column A, you must keep your child home until they are fever free and symptoms have improved.
