## Frequently Asked Questions

**Question:** I filled out the on-line registration; do I still need to come into the office at the school?

**Answer:** Yes, your child will not be registered until you provide all the documents requested in the "What to Bring Checklist".

**Question:** What Elementary School will my child attend?

**Answer:** All homes located West of Franklin Turnpike, including homes on the West side of Franklin Turnpike (on the Rite Aide side of the street) are zoned for Crescent Elementary School on Crescent Avenue.

Those homes located East of Franklin Turnpike, including homes on the East side of Franklin Turnpike (on the Burger King side of the street) are zoned for Traphagen Elementary School on Summit Avenue.

**Question:** I do not have access to a computer, how do I register my child for school?

**Question:** My child isn't due for a physical until the spring/summer, what should I do?

**Answer:** For registration, please provide us with the latest physical/immunization records you have. Then, drop off or fax the updated forms as soon as completed.

**Question:** My child will be 5 years old by October 1<sup>st</sup> and I'm not sure if my child is ready for kindergarten, what should I do?

**Answer:** We ask that you proceed with the registration process which is held in the month of January. Our Kindergarten Team will perform a screening for all children in the Spring (details will be mailed once open registration has ended). We will be happy to discuss any concerns you may have after the evaluations are completed.

**Question:** What are the school hours?

**Answer:** The Kindergarten day begins at 8:15 and students are dismissed at 2:35. Grades 1- 5 begin their day at 8:15 and are dismissed at 2:45

**Question:** I work and will need aftercare services. Does the school provide an aftercare program?

**Answer:** No, the Waldwick School District is not a provider of aftercare programs. The YMCA of Wyckoff has a program on site at the elementary schools. Please contact them for program details.
