Dear Parents,

As we work to refine our campus safety plan we will continue to enforce **NO PARKING in the parking lot** during morning Drop Off and afternoon Pick Up times. In addition, there is **NO PARKING or PICK UP of students on Summit Avenue along the school property.** Students needing to cross Summit Ave **MUST** use the crosswalk by the crossing guard. During the school day there will be a few parking spots for parents that are attending meetings and conferences or to pick up a sick child.

Drop Off:

- NO PARKING IN THE LOT!
- Students should arrive to school between 8:00 & 8:15am.
- Parents should drive toward the field and loop around to the office area.
- All students arriving by car should be dropped off in front of the office area only.
- Students should quickly unbuckle and safety patrols will assist in exiting the car. Parents **cannot** exit their car in this area.
- Please do not stop and watch your child walk the pathway. Please exit the parking lot immediately to allow for a smooth traffic flow.

Pick Up:

- NO PARKING IN THE LOT!
- DO NOT enter the campus before 2:30pm.
- **Kindergarten parents** must pull up and stop near the basketball court and wait to be waved up to the Front Office area.
- Do Not Exit your car! Your child will be escorted to your car by our Safety Patrols.
- Please have your child practice buckling their seatbelt so that you can exit the lot as soon as possible. (Safety Patrols cannot buckle your child into their seats)
- If you have an upper grade child please continue to pull up curbside and wait. (Do not exit your car)
- Please understand that students cannot be released early after 2:15pm
- Parents of students in Grades 1-5 please stop by the garbage container and wait to be called up after the kindergarten has been dismissed.

During the nice weather I encourage you to walk your children to and from school. Of course, due to these changes, parking on the surrounding streets will also be limited.

I ask for everyone's understanding and cooperation. I know that some of this may be inconvenient, but will ultimately enhance the safety and educational programs for all students on our campus.
