COOPERATIVE PROGRAM FOR FOOTBALL, WRESTLING AND CHEERLEADING BETWEEN THE MIDLAND PARK AND WALDWICK SCHOOL DISTRICTS 2024

This agreement shall apply as long as either the football and/or wrestling cooperatives exist between Waldwick and Midland Park. The agreement can be modified with joint approval of both School Boards.

This agreement shall provide a breakdown of responsibilities and understandings for the operation of the Cooperative Football, Wrestling and Cheerleading Programs involving the Midland Park and Waldwick School Districts.

GENERAL TERMS

- 1. NAME: The Waldwick/Midland Park teams shall be referred to as the Warriors over the public address system at home and away games, in cheers, and in press releases/stories. The 2 districts will also work collaboratively to identify and implement a symbolic signage representation of the Midland Park and Waldwick contract.
- 2. ELIGIBILITY: Each school district is responsible for confirming the eligibility of participants from its district both academically and medically.
- 3. RECOGNITIONS: All special honors will be entirely based on ability and performance. This would include all-league, all-county, all-state, and other awards. This excludes scholar-athlete awards. When award ceremonies are held in either school district, players from both districts will be invited to each ceremony.
- 4. GAME SCHEDULES: Will be jointly developed by the two district Athletic Directors working collaboratively.
- 5. COMMUNICATION: If either Athletic Director becomes aware of an issue connected to any of the joint programs, he/she will make sure that the other Athletic Director is apprised of the problem.

6. TRANSPORTATION:

- A. Midland Park will be responsible for:
 - --transporting participants to practices in Waldwick
 - --transporting wrestlers to matches in Waldwick
 - --busing of the Midland Park Band to any games at which the Band is performing
 - --busing the football team to every other away contest
- B. Waldwick will be responsible for:
 - --transporting participants to practices held in Midland Park
 - --transporting wrestlers to matches in Midland Park
 - --busing the football team to every other away contest

- --busing the Waldwick Band/Pep Band to any away games at which the Band is performing
- C. Midland Park and Waldwick will alternate providing transportation:
 - -- for the Wrestling Team to away matches
 - -- for teams going away to any scrimmages

TERMS SPECIFIC TO FOOTBALL, WRESTLING AND CHEERLEADING

- 1. CAPTAINS: If more than one Captain is used for a team, at least one must be from each high school. This provision can be waived with the joint agreement of both Athletic Directors.
- 2. COST SHARING: The following costs will be evenly split between the two districts: Officials fees, uniform costs, tournament fees, security (e.g., police presence) at games, reconditioning costs, and game help (e.g. ticket sellers). If the Athletic Directors agree, the school districts can provide some of the services (e.g., game help) separately with such services then excluded from the split. For example, each district may want to provide an equivalent number of supervisors.

To the extent that home Wrestling matches are alternated, it is also possible – if both Athletic Directors concur – to alternate the full provision of support staff at such matches.

If either school system elects to not participate in football and/or wrestling, the other school system has the option of continuing in that sport/those sports and absorbing all of the associated costs for that sport/those sports. Optionally, the other school system can also discontinue in that sport/those sports.

The decision to not participate in a sport must be made known to the other school system at least three months before the start of the season.

3. FIELDS/FACILITIES:

- A. Football Fields: Fields at either site can be utilized based on what is deemed best for the team and is available for use in each district. It is recognized that the Waldwick field will be used for most, if not all games and practices. However, if all involved stakeholders agree, and finances, facilities, and weather are permitting, Midland Park shall be the site of at least 1 home football game.
- B. Wrestling: Practice spaces at either site can be utilized based on what is deemed best for the team and is available for use in each district.
 - To the extent that home matches are alternated, each host site will be responsible for providing suitable facilities from mats to seating.
- C. Both Sports: Other facilities (e.g., weight rooms) will be made available to all members of the teams when not otherwise scheduled by the school district, as long as proper, approved supervision is provided.

4. COACHES

A. Football: When a new Head Coach is selected, a committee with equal representation from Waldwick and Midland Park will be created. The committee will be involved throughout the interview process. Using the input of the committee, The Waldwick Athletic Director will make a recommendation, which will be forwarded to the Waldwick Superintendent who will make the final decision and recommendation to the Waldwick Board of Education. Waldwick will pay for the Head Coach salary, accordingly.

When an Assistant/Associate Head Coach is selected, a committee with equal representation from Waldwick and Midland Park will be created. The committee will be involved throughout the interview process. Using the input of the committee, The Midland Park Athletic Director will make a recommendation, which will be forwarded to the Midland Park Superintendent, who will make the final decision and recommendation to the Midland Park Board of Education. Midland Park will be responsible for the salary of this Assistant/Associate Head Coach.

Each district will select and pay for at least two Assistant Coaches. The selection process will include input from both district's Director of Athletics.

If there is a dispute about a desired coach for selection, then the paying district will have the final say as to who is selected.

B. Wrestling: When a new Head Coach is selected, a committee with equal representation from Waldwick and Midland Park will be created. The committee will be involved throughout the interview process. Using the input of the committee, the Waldwick Athletic Director will then make a recommendation to the Waldwick Superintendent of Schools, who will make the final decision and recommendation to the Waldwick Board of Education. Waldwick will pay the Head Coach salary, accordingly.

When an Assistant/Associate Head Coach is selected, a committee with equal representation from Waldwick and Midland Park will be created. The committee will be involved throughout the interview process. Using the input of the committee, The Midland Park Athletic Director will make a recommendation, which will be forwarded to the Midland Park Superintendent, who will make the final decision and recommendation to the Midland Park Board of Education. Midland Park will be responsible for the salary of this Assistant/Associate Head Coach.

C. Cheerleading: When a new Head Coach is selected, a committee with equal representation from Waldwick and Midland Park will be created. The committee will be involved throughout the interview process. Using the input of the committee, the Waldwick Athletic Director will then make a recommendation to the Waldwick Superintendent of Schools, who will make the final decision and recommendation to the Waldwick Board of Education. Waldwick will pay the Head Coach salary, accordingly.

When an Assistant/Associate Head Coach is selected, a committee with equal representation from Waldwick and Midland Park will be created. The committee will be involved throughout the interview process. Using the input of the committee, The Midland Park Athletic Director will make a recommendation, which will be forwarded to the Midland Park Superintendent, who will make the final decision and recommendation to the Midland Park Board of Education. Midland Park will be responsible for the salary of this Assistant/Associate Head Coach.

D. Each School District will notify the other of Board approval agendas/dates for all coaches including volunteer coaches on each staff.

TERMS SPECIFIC TO FOOTBALL

Each Band will perform at half time for up to five of the ten scheduled football games, at least two of which will be home games, as long as both districts are operating a band program during football season. Band Directors will work collaboratively to determine the exact schedule. If they disagree, the Athletic Directors will work collaboratively to determine the exact schedule.

If either school is without a Band program during a period of transition, the other school's Band has the option of using the half-time performance slot at all games.

If not performing at half time, the other Band can perform before the game after the football squads depart the field and/or provide entertainment from the stands during the game.

Whenever feasible, both Bands will join to perform the National Anthem before each game.

Uniforms - Waldwick High School has the players purchase their home and away jerseys for the players to keep. Midland Park allows their players to purchase their jerseys but does not require it. The schools will provide football pants and extra jerseys for the players that do not purchase their jerseys and they will be returned to the program at the end of the season.

TERMS SPECIFIC TO WRESTLING

1. Home and away matches will be alternated or evenly divided during the season, as long as the facilities and bussing at each district permit. This also includes the services of the Athletic Trainer and staff services.

- 2. If one or more wrestlers on the team qualify for the State Wrestling Tournament, all associated costs will be evenly divided. It is further noted that when both Coaches attend, they must travel together with the wrestler(s) and must share a room. Any competitor(s) will have a separate room. State mileage rates and federal food rates will apply to this trip.
- 3. If the coaches remain at the tournament for any days after all Midland Park-Waldwick entries have been eliminated, they must cover their own food costs.

Uniforms - Waldwick High School may have the players purchase their singlets for the players to keep. Midland Park allows their players to purchase their singlets but does not require it. The schools will provide singlets for the players that do not purchase their own and they will be returned to the program at the end of the season.

TERMS SPECIFIC TO CHEERLEADING

Fall: A merged squad will be operated with Waldwick responsible for the selection and payment of the Head Advisor. Midland Park will select and pay for an Assistant Advisor. The input of the Head Advisor will be sought during the selection process.

Winter: The winter season will consist of a varsity competition team and a junior varsity team that will cheer at select basketball games at both schools when the schools are not competing against each other.

In any cooperative program unexpected situations can arise which are not covered by this accord. When such situations do arise, the Athletic Directors – after consultation with their respective Superintendents – will seek to resolve the matters. If they are unsuccessful, the matters will be forwarded to the Superintendents to seek to resolve.

This Letter Agreement outlines the terms under which Delta-T Group North Jersey, Inc. ("Delta-T") will refer interim professionals to **Waldwick School District** ("Client"). This Agreement shall commence on the date first stated above and continue for an initial term of one (1) year or such shorter period in the event that the parties execute a more comprehensive agreement. This Agreement shall automatically renew for successive 1-year terms. This Agreement may be terminated without cause by either party upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other party.

The professionals referred to Client through Delta-T are Independent Contractors ("Contractor(s)"). Delta-T requires, as part of its arrangement with the Contractors, that each Contractor sign an operating agreement with Delta-T before they are contracted out to Client's facility.

If payment is not made in accordance with these terms, Delta-T will cease referring Contractors to Client and Contractors will not be released for referral until payment is received in full. Delta-T shall be entitled to recover reasonable attorneys fees in the event legal action is necessary to enforce the terms of this Letter Agreement.
